Parent Champion Scheme

Sara Saudella, Parent Champion Co-ordinator, BFfC, spoke about the Parent Champion Scheme. Slides attached are self-explanatory of what the scheme does. Parent Champions are parent volunteers and Fathima, who is a parent volunteer, spoke about it from her perspective. Fathima thought "why not give it a go?" – and she is really glad she has joined the team. It is on the Local Offer.

Chair's Report

Ramona talked through the Chair's section of the Annual Report – attached. Reading had its Ofsted/CQC Inspection recently. It was found that Services are improving, but also clearly identified a number of areas where services have to improve. It is hoped that more members will be at next year's AGM. Alice and Maryam thanked Ramona for her hard work.

Treasurer's Report 2020-21

Accounts had been circulated prior to the AGM. Alice explained the expenditure and accounts. Expenditure is down this year mainly because

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of events being held on line. We have not got the capacity to fund raise. The Forum has received £5000 to fund a video project - for young people to give advice to teachers and staff of what they would like from teachers. The filming is taking place on 9th October at The Avenue School, by Shuut – a well-regarded company.
